Key Takeaways

- ERCOT's Money Market Mutual Fund (MMMF) investment yields are consistent with the April yields reported at the prior F&A meeting. As of the end of June 2024, ERCOT's MMMF yields equaled approximately 5.17% and the purchase yield of ERCOT's U.S. Treasury Obligation Portfolio equaled approximately 5.21%
- ERCOT is in compliance with all investment requirements for June
 - ERCOT was out of compliance with one component for one day in May. On May 14, 2024, one MMMF was beyond the 10% threshold at 10.28%. It was brought back into compliance the following day
