1.1. Request for Proposal (RFP) Objective

The objective of ERCOT in this procurement is to identify and contract with a qualified Respondent to provide a projection of annual growth in MWs for large data centers, including crypto mining and AI facilities in the ERCOT Region for years 2025 through 2034.
